

National Truth & Reconciliation Day (Orange Shirt Day)

September 30 is National Truth and Reconciliation Day, also known as *Orange Shirt Day*, a time to honour residential school survivors and remember the children who never returned home. Established in response to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Call to Action #80, this day invites us to reflect on the history and legacy of residential schools.

As part of our commitment to reconciliation, Bishop Fabbro has asked that a land acknowledgement be read at specific weekend Masses, beginning this weekend, in preparation for the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation on Tuesday.
