





St. Peter's SSVP Update

During the month of March, St. Peter's Saint Vincent de Paul Society made 47 visits to help 73 of the poor in our midst. We distributed \$3180 in grocery gift cards to these people as well as 19 vouchers from our York St. store for furniture, clothing and household items. In addition, we are trying to help the truly homeless whom we see daily on our streets. Here is a brief outline of one such encounter:

"Dear parish members, your generous giving to our parish community needs is gratefully appreciated. Besides going to family homes, we also use your donations to serve our sisters and brothers on the street. Two weeks ago, on a cold night, I was driving down King Street long after dark when I saw 5 people huddled in a closed store front. Pulling over I asked if they could each use a Tim Horton card. Their individual gratitude for the \$10 card was very moving. All of them expressed multiple thanks for my stopping to deliver a card you have provided. This was possible through your generous giving. Thank you."


