A Different Kind of Fasting in Lent

FAST from anger and hatred.

Instead learn the discipline of love. "Love covers a multitude of sins." Give your family an extra dose of love each day. (1 Peter 4:8)

FAST from judging others.

Before making any judgements, recall how Jesus overlooks our faults. Instead concentrate on people's best points. We all have faults. (*Luke 6:37-42*)

FAST from discouragement.

Hold onto Jesus' promise that he has a perfect plan for your life. Anxiety is spending emotional energy on something we can do nothing about: like tomorrow! Live today and let God's grace be sufficient. (*Matthew 6:26-34*)

FAST from complaining and grumbling.

When you find yourself about to complain, close your eyes and recall some of the little moments of joy that Jesus has given you. Instead of complaining, "In everything give thanks." Constructive criticism is okay, however moaning, groaning, and complaining are not Christian disciplines. (*Philippians 2:14*)

FAST from resentment and bitterness.

Work on forgiving those who may have hurt you. (*Matthew 6:14*)

FAST from spending too much money.

Try to reduce your spending by 10%, and give those savings to the poor. We are called to be stewards of God's riches, not consumers. (*Matthew 6:19-21*)
