Confirmation is an important, unrepeatable Sacrament in the Catholic Church. It is a deepening of the Love that was poured out upon your children during the Sacrament of Baptism. We are grateful for the faith that has been instilled in your children as they begin to take responsibility for their own faith-formation. The Church teaches that the **family is the domestic Church** (*St. John Paul II, Familiaris Consortio, pp 21, 49, 1981*). This means that as parents, you have a deeper impact on your children's faith development than the employees of the Church or our Catholic Schools. Both the schools and ministers of the Church are present to support and reinforce your efforts.

The style of the meetings each night will involve a similar format that begins with opening prayer, followed by the presentation and an opportunity for small group discussion.
