



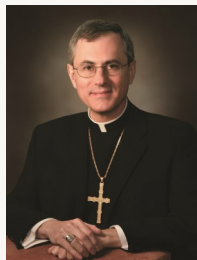

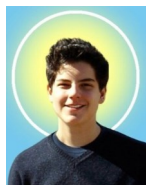
### Do You Feel Called to Support Vocations to the Priesthood & Consecrated Life?

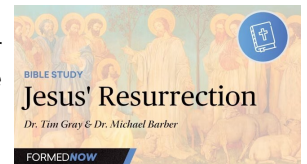
