







court hearings scheduled and because of adjournments and a Federal holiday, the next court hearing is scheduled for later this year in December. The Diocese will continue to update the parish as plans move forward with the property.

Parking Options



As a reminder, below are the parking options at St. Michael's Parish and St. Peter's Cathedral. Please arrive to Mass in advance of the Mass time to secure a parking spot. Parking on the lawn, blocking driving lanes, or double parking is prohibited. This could result in emergency vehicles not being able to access the churches should the need arise.

St. Michael's Parish

Parking is available weekdays before 4:00 pm:

- Behind the Parish please note parking next to St. Michael's school is for school staff from Sept 1 - July 1 (for the entire school year).
- At the front of the Parish next to the offices
- On Cheapside Street, Maitland Street or Harrison Ave.

Parking is available weekdays after 4:00 pm and weekends:

- Behind the Parish no restrictions
- At the front of the Parish next to the offices
- On Cheapside Street, Maitland Street or Harrison Ave.

Please **DO NOT** park in front of the Rectory garage at any time. This includes days, afternoons and evenings both weekdays and weekends.

St. Peter's Cathedral

Parking is available weekdays during mass times:

- In the South Parking lot this is located closest to the entrance/Narthex
- On Clarence Street or Dufferin Ave.

Parking is available weekends during mass times:

- In the South Parking lot
- In the Middle Parking lot this is the gated lot next to the South lot
- In the North Parking lot this lot is north of the former school and for overflow on Sundays from 8:45 am - 9:15 am and 10:45 am - 11:15 am.
- On Clarence Street or Dufferin Ave.

Please note when the parking gate arm is down in the Middle or North lot the lot is full or card access is required.
