

Eat this Bread, Drink this Cup-The Cup Returns this Weekend

The church has always taught that Christ is fully present in the Eucharist in the form of the consecrated bread (host) OR

consecrated wine. Communion by the Cup was a common practice in both parishes prior to the pandemic. Over the last week, our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion have participated in some ministry formation and re-training to prepare to reintroduce the cup this weekend. Thank you to those who have served in this ministry and to all those new individuals who have come forward to serve their brothers and sisters.



"Baptism and Eucharist - birth and food - are closely related. Once we are born into the Christian life, we need to be nourished regularly so that we may live and work as God's beloved family. Each time we take part in the Eucharist and receive Communion, we are given a deeper share in the life and love of Jesus, our brother and our Lord. We are nourished with the bread of life and the cup of salvation. We share in Jesus' promise of everlasting life, and we have a first taste of the glorious banquet that Jesus will give us when we join with him at his table in heaven. Communion from the cup helps us to have a fuller experience of the joyful banquet to which Jesus is inviting all his brothers and sisters." (CCCB, Communion by the Cup, 2019).

For those who choose to receive from the Cup, the proper reception is as follows:



"After responding with Amen, we take the eucharistic bread as usual in the hand or on the tongue, and eat it with reverence. Then we approach the minister with the cup. This minister gives us the cup, saying The blood of Christ. We answer Amen, and take it with both hands, one on the base, the other on the stem or bottom of the cup. We lift it gently to our lips, drink a small amount, and return the cup to the minister, who wipes the cup carefully and

thoroughly." (CCCB)

Our custom of a sign of reverence through a bow is done before receiving both the consecrated bread and wine.

The Nicene Creed

The Jubilee Year of 2025 marks the 1700th anniversary of the original Creed of Nicaea. It was drawn up by the bishops and theologians who gathered at the first Ecumenical Council in Nicaea (modernday Turkey) in 325 to settle a dispute about Jesus, since some were saying that he was only a special human being but not God. The Scriptures, of course, were clear about how Jesus revealed himself as human and divine, son of Mary and



Son of God, but the Church needed to find the right words to explain this mystery. At the Council it was declared that Jesus is consubstantial with the Father. The next Ecumenical Council, held at Constantinople would add to the Creed and made it clear that the Holy Spirit is also God, of the same substance. The expanded Creed would come to be known as the "Nicene Creed."

This weekend, Pope Leo XIV will visit the site of the first Ecumenical Council of Nicea. In advance of his journey, he has written an apostolic letter *In Unitate Fidei*—In The Unity of Faith to mark this significant anniversary of the Creed and to provide a renewed appreciation and meaning of our profession of faith. 
