2023 Financial Highlights for St. Michael's Parish

Total operating revenue in 2023 increased by \$65,089. Annual offertory increased by \$87,612 but was offset by a decrease of \$24,624 for Easter and Thanksgiving donations.

Total operating costs increased by less than 1%. This is attributed to the sharing of costs between the family of parishes.

The Balance Sheet indicates a strong financial position with an accumulated surplus of \$655,529 in 2023, up from \$448,535 in 2022.

The Loan (Savings) Fund has a balance of \$439,873. Generous bequests and dollars transferred from the operating account doubled the loan fund in 2023.

2023 Financial Highlights for St. Peter's Cathedral

Total operating revenue decreased in 2023 by \$179,609. The decrease is a result of no revenue from the north parking lot and a significant decrease in tenant rent from the Parish Centre. Offertory and donations in 2023 increased by \$86,370.

Total operating expenses were down by \$161,142 in 2023 due to no rent paid to the Diocese for office and meeting space in the Parish Centre and cost sharing between the family of parishes.

The Balance Sheet indicates a strong financial position with an accumulated surplus of \$1,448,091, up from \$980,374 in 2022.

The loan (savings) fund has a balance of \$1,189,877. The fund increased by \$555,043 in 2023 because of an individual bequest of \$250,000, several generous donations, and dollars transferred from the operating account.

Thank you to our many parishioners for their generous financial support. Our parishes ended 2023 with a surplus of funds. However, offertory contributions and other donations are needed to continue to support the many costs of our parishes. Your contributions go into building up our parish community so that we can continue now, and in the future to be a mission-oriented Church that forms disciples of Jesus.
