



Amazed by Jesus

"Every year today's liturgy leaves us amazed: we pass from the joy of welcoming Jesus as he enters Jerusalem to the sorrow of watching him condemned to death and then crucified. That sense of interior amazement will remain with us throughout Holy Week.

From the start, Jesus leaves us amazed. His people give him a solemn welcome, yet he enters Jerusalem on a lowly colt. His people expect a powerful liberator at Passover, yet he comes to bring the Passover to fulfilment by sacrificing himself. His people are hoping to triumph over the Romans by the sword, but Jesus comes to celebrate God's triumph through the cross.





During this Holy Week, let us lift our eyes to the cross, in order to receive the grace of amazement. Let us gaze upon Jesus on the cross and say to him: "Lord, how much you love me! How precious I am to you!" Let us be amazed by Jesus so that we can start living again, for the grandeur of life lies not in possessions and promotions, but in realizing that we are loved. This is the grandeur of life: discovering that we are loved. And the grandeur of life lies precisely in the beauty of love. "

But this past month we made our way up to her apartment and knocked on her door. She eagerly invited us into her home. As we stepped in, she recognized me from past visits and asked me how I was doing. We talked about her day and how much this grocery store gift card was going to help her this month. She thanked us for taking the time to come up to her apartment and to deliver her much needed gift card, voucher for some clothing at the thrift store and bus ticket. Holy Thursday Collection

On Holy Thursday, our collection has been taken up in support of a local service organization. This year's collection at St. Michael's and St. Peter's will be for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul Particular Council's Affordable Housing Project, Building Hope for Homes. The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul (SSVP) is a not-for-profit organization whose mission is to serve people in need with love, respect, justice and joy, and to help create a more just and compassionate society. The Society has been serving people in London for over 160 years!

There is a chronic need for affordable housing in London and surrounding area. Currently, there are over 6,250 families and/or individuals in need of safe, secure housing. In response to the chronic and acute affordable housing crisis in London, the SSVP has obtained a portion of property from the Diocese of London adjacent to St. Andrew the Apostle Church located in northeast London. The plan is to build a 73 -unit apartment building that will contain one and two bedroom units - with 17 accessible and all designated affordable - including space for community support on the ground floor.
