

May you and your families be filled with the wonder of Mary, the obedience of Joseph, the joy of the angels, the eagerness of the shepherds, the determination of the Magi, and the profound peace of the Christ child.

On behalf of our entire parish team, I wish you a most blessed and joyous Christmas. May the newborn King fill your hearts with His grace, and may His love sustain you throughout the coming year.

Every Christmas, we are invited to return to the stable at Bethlehem. God's heart, God's light, God's humility was given to us on that holy night and that all encompassing and radiant light continues to touch us, bless us, direct us, and guide us.

The Season of Christmas

Next to the yearly celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter, the Church holds most sacred the memorial of Christ's birth and early manifestations. The season of Christmas begins for us on **Christmas Day (and its vigil)** and concludes with the **Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.** Throughout the season the church's liturgies invite and guide our hearts to reflect on the meaning of Christmas-the gift of self-giving love.

We quickly transition into Jesus' public life on the **Feast of the Holy Family** as we hear the familiar gospel story of Jesus teaching in the temple. The following Sunday we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord** in which we are reminded the light of the world had come into the darkness of the world. Matthew's Gospel brings us the story of the Magi and their encounter with Herod on their way to pay homage to the newborn king. The Season of Christmas draws to a conclusion with the **Feast of Baptism of the Lord** where Jesus is baptized by John, the skies open and the voice of God proclaims: "you are my beloved Son." In all of these celebrations we come to a greater understanding and insight into the essence of who Jesus really isteacher, light, and Son.
